Biography

Patrick Huard is an actor, comedian, director, author, host and producer. This year, he is celebrating his 40th birthday and 20 years in the business. He has appeared in some 15 feature films including *La Vie après l'Amour*, *Nez Rouge*, *Sur le Seuil*, *Maman Last Call*, *Monica la Mitraille*, *Bon Cop Bad Cop* (one of the highest-grossing Canadian films of all time, for which he wrote the script) and, more recently, *Cadavres*. He has just completed shooting the feature film *Funky Town*, which will be released in the summer of 2010.

His television work - he has played good guys, bad guys and even a drag queen - includes the series *Music Hall*, *Cover Girl*, *Fortier*, *Au Nom de la Loi*. He can currently be seen on the TVA network in the fourth season of *Taxi 0-22*, a series he is producing and in which he plays the role of Rogatien, his famous taxi driver who shoots from the lip. He received the 2008 and 2009 Artis trophy in the Artist – comedy program category for this role.

Patrick Huard loves the stage. He has presented two hit one-man shows: *18 ans et plus* and *Face à Face*. He has also participated in several *Juste pour rire* (Just for Laughs) galas and had a role in Eric Bogosian's play *Talk Radio*, with some 1,200 performances and hundreds of thousands of tickets sold in Quebec. He has hosted several awards shows for *Juste pour rire*, ADISQ, the Jutras, as well as several daily radio shows and comedy series on Radio-Canada.

In addition to *Taxi 0-22*, **Patrick** has also produced music videos, commercials, a documentary for Canal D and a first feature film, *Les 3 P'tits Cochons*, Québec's top box office hit in 2007. He is currently directing his second feature film, *Filière 13*.
